Mathematics

During the term we will cover the following objectives, in a variety of different contexts:

-This term is mostly about fractions.

We will learn to simplify, compare and order fractions. Add and subtract fractions. Multiply and divide fractions. We will also be doing word problems and mixed calculations of fractions.

We will then go on to Geometry and cover position and direction: coordinated in all four quadrants, translations and reflections.

PSHE: Jigsaw.

We will be looking at the differences between people and discussing the idea of 'normal'. We will look at bullying behaviours and how difference can be a cause of conflict or celebration.
