## Mathematics

During the term we will focus on decimals, percentages and geometry.

We will:

- Identify the value of each digit in numbers given to 3 decimal places
- multiply numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000 giving answers up to 3 decimal places.
- Multiply one-digit numbers with up to 2 decimal places by whole numbers.
- Use written division methods in cases where the answer has up to 2 decimal places.
- Solve problems which require answers to be rounded to specified degrees of accuracy.
- Solve problems involving the calculation of percentages of whole numbers or measures such as 15% of 360 and the use of percentages for comparison
- Recall and use equivalences between simple fractions, decimals and percentages, including in different contexts
